- 12) Update on project - application DIR-2023-2788-CDP-MEL-HCA and ENV-2023-2789-CE in which they're proposing to demolish an existing 4 car garage associated with a 4-unit apartment building then rebuild a new 4 car garage with a 1,200 square foot ADU and roof deck on top with 2nd floor storage area above the garage at 425-431 W. 40th St. San Pedro, CA 90731.
